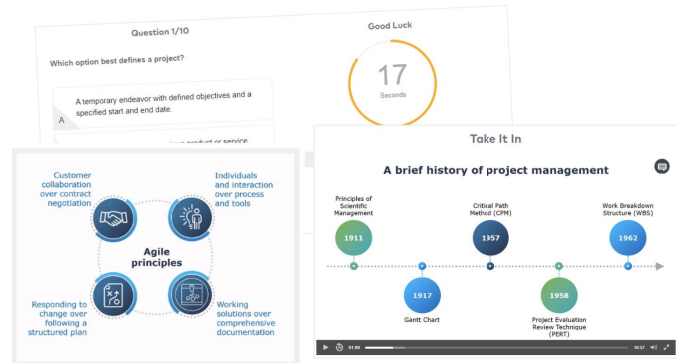
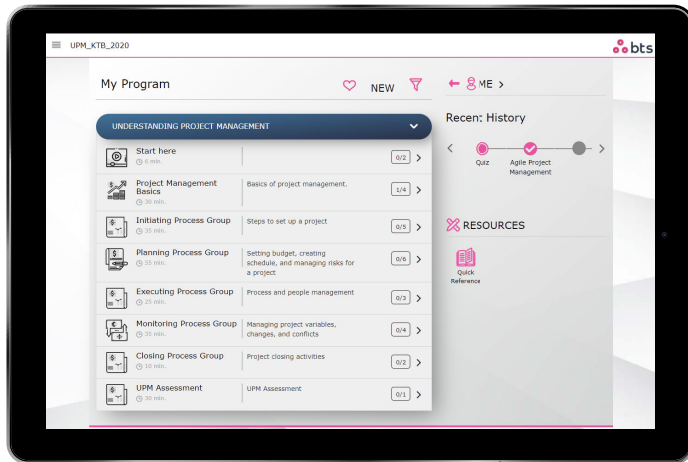


Understanding Project Management (UPM)

It can also be used as an ongoing reference tool to **reinforce concepts and prior learning**. Implementation

The **self-paced**, 4-hour program comprises **18 learning bursts in 6 modules**. Each module includes a timed quiz to assess learning. The final assessment is in the form of a rich, moments-based simulation at the end of the program.
